
ELPHABA

Elphaba was one of a group of siblings that were sent to a reconditioning center. In her way back for her release she somehow broke her wings. They wing did not heal in such a way that she could be released. Her endearing personality made us excited to bring her into your Ambassador Program.

The American Kestrel is the smallest and most common falcon in North America. The American kestrel usually hunts by perching and scanning the ground for prey to ambush, though it also hunts from the air. It sometimes hovers in the air with rapid wing beats while homing in on prey. Its diet typically consists of <u>grasshoppers</u> and other insects, <u>lizards</u>, mice, and small birds. In contrast to many other raptor species, the sexes differ more in plumage than in size. Males have blue-grey <u>wings</u> with black spots and white undersides with black barring. Females have more rufous coloring with black barring.

ORION

Orion was a nestling when he came in. He was in a habituated state and the Hope was that he could be wilded back up. In spite of our best efforts using conspecifics to help him reestablish his natural connection to the Kestrel world we were unsuccessful. After determining that we were not going to be able to release him in his habituated state we decided to keep him as an education bird.



The Case for Copper



Lead toxicity is a significant cause of injury in birds of prey, notably bald eagles and vultures.

1 in 3 birds tested in the past 10 years by the Wildlife Center of Virginia suffer from some level of lead poisoning!

Birds ingest lead when eating contaminated carcasses, remains left in the field, or consuming live, but contaminated prey.

FEW BIRDS SURVIVE LEAD POISONING

Lead is a heavy metal, and is absorbed into the blood stream after being broken down by digestive fluids and stomach acid.

Symptoms include listlessness, inability to maintain balance, refusal to eat, head tilt, and convulsions.

Lead poisoning requires a combination of oral and injected chelation treatments, taking several months. Even successfully treated birds may have permanent injuries, like cardiac and vision damage.





NO AMOUNT OF LEAD IS SAFE

Copper bullets remain intact and mushroom on impact. The entire bullet can be removed.

Non-lead ammunition costs approxiately the same as lead.

Bury guts; do not leave game in the field.

A standard 130 grain bullet has enough lead to kill **102 eagles**



And other wildlife conflicts and questions.


